



Environmental policy document

Paramedic Rescue Services (PRS) Limited has adopted the following principle in order to contribute, in some small part, to the reduction of CO₂ in the environment.

As a company, we will no longer produce printed products as described below:

- 1. Student aide-memoirs.
- 2. Manuals, booklets or leaflets, described as 'handouts', for students registered on a course or session run by PRS.
- 3. Promotional or advertising materials, unless as part of a planned and limited campaign, where other options have been considered primarily (i.e. email).
- 4. Order forms, feedback forms or any other type of form required as part of our administrative and corporate activities.
- 5. Written cheques as a means of making payments to suppliers or subcontactors.
- 6. Accounts and Inland Revenue returns.

This list is not exhaustive but outlines the company's commitment within the scope of materials that would be expected to be produced during any given period of corporate activity.

Alternatives are offered and these include the availability of online forms, books, leaflets and promotional materials. Payments are made via BACS or using other electronic bank transfer facilities and accounts are created and submitted entirely online.
